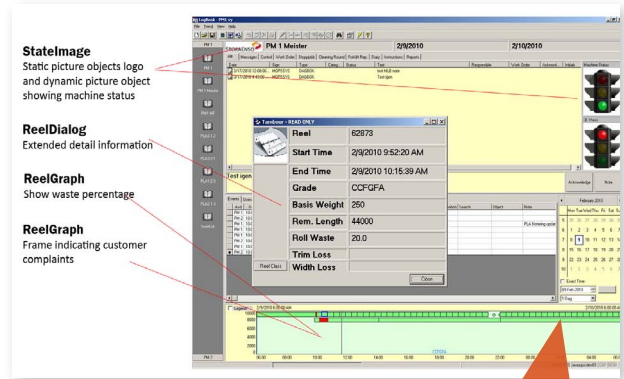

MOPS Releases

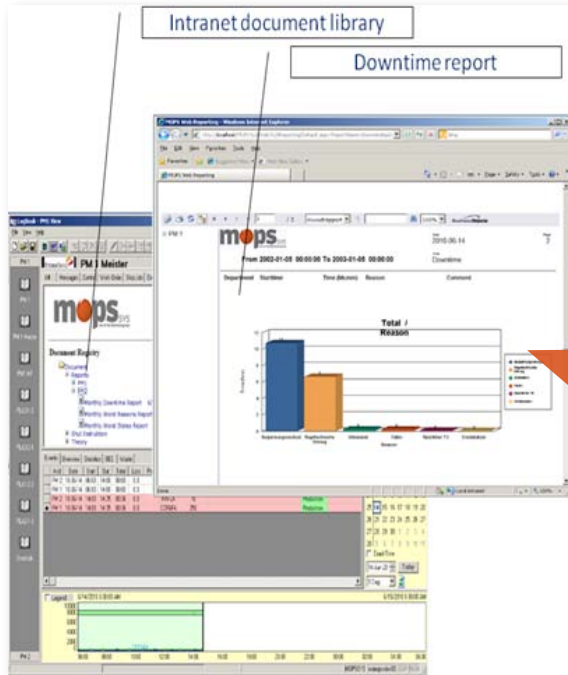
Version 13.1.3 is now released and contains changes in branding and 64 bit support.

Version 13.2 is planned to November and will among other things contain support for Oracle 11g, User Account Control (UAC) and Localized documentation.



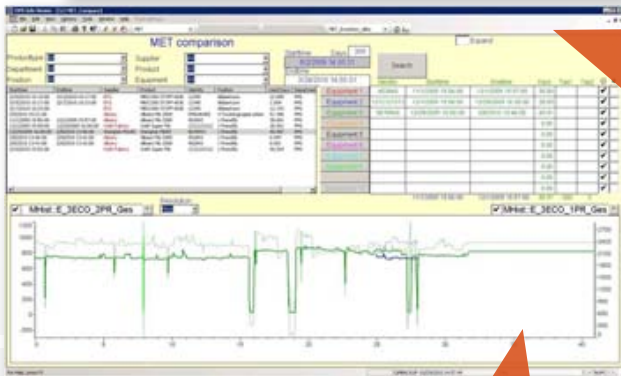
MOPS Logbook
